
Newsletter

Dear partner,

"Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide is the gate, and broad is the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: Because strait is the gate, and narrow is the way, which

leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it."



Most people are familiar with this verse in Scripture. I think the best way to find out what these narrow and/or broad ways are, is to look at the explanation of the one who wrote it. In this case, Jesus Himself. Then maybe it is better to listen to the whole sermon of Jesus. As mentioned above, the way that leads to life is narrow, not easy. For many it is already difficult to read that whole sermon. That famous 'Sermon on the mount' starts at chapter 5 and ends at the end of chapter 7. Now that is a problem in this time that we are living in. Our lives are so hectic, that we actually do not have time anymore for what really matters. Jesus' life on earth was also hectic. And yet, He knew He wouldn't survive if He did not seek His Father and draw His strength from Him. He knew He would be quickened by spending time with His Father, more than if He would use that time to sleep or 'relax'. I am not saying we should not sleep, but there are times when we need to sacrifice. If you know how dependent you are on God, how you have to, and want to, stay connected to the source, Jesus Christ, you will fight for your time alone with Him. You will take time to be in the Word. If He comes first in your life, you will also desire to know Him more and more. How can we ever get to know God better, without the Word of God?

Interesting, that right after verses 13 and 14 Jesus starts to talk about false prophets. Verse 15 "Beware

of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves." There are a lot of doctrines at this moment that directly contradict this teaching of Jesus. Now, I could write down a whole list of all these contradictions, but honestly, a lot has been prophesied in the Bible, in the Old as well as in the New Testament, about the last days. One of them says that there will be many false teachers and prophets, but also that people will want the preachers who tell them what they like to hear.

Jesus said in John 7:17 that if anyone has the will to do the will of God, he shall know whether the teaching comes from God or not. If we want to know the will of God, and do not want to be misled, we will have to check everything in the Word of God. If we feel quite comfortable with every wind of doctrine, and I mean, if our flesh feels comfortable with every teaching that comes across on the internet, according to Paul we are still babies. Now I can go and explain why something is not right, but, him that has ears to hear, let him hear.

Let us check our priorities and make time for the Word of God. Let us search ourselves. 'Do I really want to know God's opinion? Only then will the Holy Spirit be able to convince us of the Truth. He is also the One Who will help us on that narrow, difficult way. The same way Jesus went, Whom we truly love to follow!

Mission trips

Malaysia

On 10 May Vernon and Matthew arrived back in Holland, after three weeks of mission in Malaysia. It could become a bit boring, but again people were healed, delivered and saved by the power of God.
