

Not only that same hope, the salvation of our souls for eternity, but also hope for today, that our risen Lord is with us. Does that make any difference to you? That the Lord Jesus is with you, in the midst of your circumstances? Or can you only see your circumstances, without seeing Jesus at all? In that case I would like to encourage you to find out how you can be born again. Then you will also be able to love Him and rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory, though now you see Him not (yet), though He has not changed your current circumstances (vet). You believe Him, no matter what circumstances you are facing. Let us start this new year with looking forward with hope; our eyes focused on our God.
